IOMC MOU FUNCTIONS

- 5.1 The functions of the IOCC shall be the following:
 - (a) to consult on the planning, programming, funding, implementation and monitoring of activities undertaken jointly or individually by the Participating Organizations with regard to the sound management of chemicals **Item 7(b)**
 - (b) to identify gaps and areas of overlap in such activities and recommend ways to reduce or eliminate themItem 7(b)
 - (c) to make recommendations on the distribution of work among the Participating Organizations with regard to the sound management of chemicals Items 5(f, g, h) and 8
 - (d) to recommend common policies to be pursued by the Participating Organizations
 - (e) to encourage the Participating Organizations to undertake joint programmes for the sound management of chemicals

 - (f) to endorse specific activities planned or undertaken by one or more of the Participating Organizations as being within the framework of the Programme **Item 10**
 - (g) to exchange information about the activities undertaken and planned to be undertaken, jointly or separately, by the Participating Organizations with regard to the sound management of chemicals Item 7(b)
 - (h) to review actions taken, and to consider recommendations made, by other organizations, programmes and intergovernmental meetings and arrangements (such as the Intergovernmental Forum on Chemical Safety) concerning matters within the scope of the Programme, as well as to consider possible follow-up which might be given by the Participating Organizations
