IOMC MOU FUNCTIONS

- 5.1 The functions of the IOCC shall be the following:

 - (f) to endorse specific activities planned or undertaken by one or more of the Participating Organizations as being within the framework of the Programme Item 5
 - (g) to exchange information about the activities undertaken and planned to be undertaken, jointly or separately, by the Participating Organizations with regard to the sound management of chemicals Item 7
 - (h) to review actions taken, and to consider recommendations made, by other organizations, programmes and intergovernmental meetings and arrangements (such as the Intergovernmental Forum on Chemical Safety) concerning matters within the scope of the Programme, as well as to consider possible follow-up which might be given by the Participating Organizations Items 5 & 6
 - to make recommendations to such organizations, programmes and intergovernmental meetings and arrangements
